Level 1 Confined Space Worker - 3 Days No Breathing Apparatus

LEVEL 1 is targeted at employee's who are engaged in performing work on or in the confined space or who have ancillary roles such as standby duties.

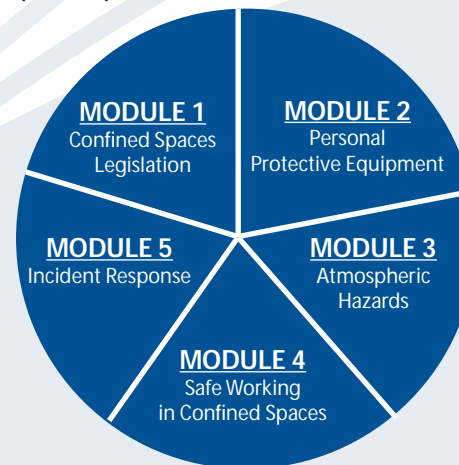

Level 3 Confined Space Supervisor / Planner 4 - 5 Days

LEVEL 3 is the full program covering all the relevant competencies. It combines Level 1 & 2 and Emergency Response.

5 Modules of Level 3

The structure of the Confined Space Training Program consists of five streams as described in each level. The other 5 modularised individual topics namely Confined Space Legislation, Personal Protective Equipment, Atmospheric Hazards and Monitoring, Safe Working in Confined Spaces and Incident Response can be offered as stand alone modules, making this a very flexible training package of 10 Modules.

Awareness Program for Confined Space Manager / Controller - 1 Day

This covers management of Confined Space Entry, Document Controller, Risk Assessments and the development of Safe Work Methods.

Level 2 Confined Space Worker - 4 Days With Breathing Apparatus

LEVEL 2 is targeted at employee's who are engaged in work in the confined space where the operation and wearing of breathing apparatus may be necessary or who have ancillary roles such as standby duties.

All the training programs may be conducted on the clients site or at any of the four Mines Rescue Stations within NSW. The majority of these programs are accredited and aim at all levels of employees.
